## LEADERSHIP LAB

Romans 12:6-8 <sup>6</sup> We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; <sup>7</sup> if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; <sup>8</sup> if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully.

Lead "proistamai" - guide, lead, direct

<u>Diligently</u> "spoude" – do quickly, hurry, haste (Lk 1:39)

- Leaders take action.
- Great leaders are focused on taking action; average leaders are focused on perfecting.
- Leaders stay focused on the vision.
- Just as much as we are doing, we need to be undoing.
- There is difference between being in motion and action.
