Romans 12:6-8 ⁶ We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; ⁷ if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; ⁸ if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; **if it is to lead, do it diligently**; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully.

Lead “*proistamai*” – guide, lead, direct

Diligently “*spoudē*” – do quickly, hurry, haste (Lk 1:39)

- Leaders take action.
- Great leaders are focused on taking action; average leaders are focused on perfecting.
- Leaders stay focused on the vision.
- Just as much as we are doing, we need to be undoing.
- There is difference between being in motion and action.
