1. Know God

Sunday Services

We consider reaching people who do not know God personally to be one of our greatest responsibilities. Our Sunday services are for people at all stages in their spiritual journey, but our heart is to see people who don't know God, find Him. Our Sunday services focus on four values:

1.Celebration

We believe church should be enjoyable.

"I was glad when they said to me,' Let us go into the house of the Lord." Psalm 122:1

2.Inspiration

We believe church should be a place where people experience God's presence.

3.Preparation

We believe church should be a place where people learn how the Bible applies to their daily lives.

"So Christ Himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, to equip His people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up." Ephesians 4:11-12

4.Salvation

We believe church should be a place where people can accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

"Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.' But how can they call on Him to save them unless they believe in Him? And how can they believe in Him if they have never heard about Him? And how can they hear about Him unless someone tells them? Romans 10:13-14

How We Share Christ with Others:

"Go out into the country...and urge anyone you find to come, so that the house will be full." Luke 14:23

As we continue to reach people far from God, every one of us can do our part by following these 4 principles:

- 1. Accept the personal responsibility.
- 2. Build a personal relationship.
- 3. Share your personal **story**.
- 4. Give a personal invitation.

In our community, our nation, and our world

In addition to our efforts during Sunday services, we are focused on reaching people in three key places designated by Jesus:

1.**Our Community**

The primary way we reach our community is through our Sunday Services, Serve Day projects, connecting with schools, and providing freedom and support groups.

2.Our nation

The primary way we reach our nation is by supporting church planting organizations and American missionaries.

3.Our World

The primary way we reach our world is through strategic missions. We support several missionaries who are serving in areas that extend the reach of our church. Reaching beyond ourselves and partnering with other missionaries and missions organizations is core to who we are as a church. How do I get involved?:

1.Pray

Pray that we might reach people in each of these areas with the Good News of Jesus.

Matthew 9:37-38 "Then He said to His disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into His harvest field." If you notice, the verse says the harvest is plentiful. People want and need to know Jesus, but the workers are few. It says to ask the Lord, that means pray....we can ask for this in prayer.

2. **Give**

Give your time and resources to reach people for Christ.

Matthew 6:19-21 says "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in Heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will also be."

3. **Go**

Go to our cities, nation, and world to serve others and show people the love of God.

Isaiah 6:8 says "Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, 'whom shall I send? And who will go for us?' And I said, "here am I. Send me! ..."

2.) Find Freedom

We believe life change happens in the context of relationships. Groups have one simple purpose: to bring people together. God created us to live in community with others, and it is only then that we can experience the full life He intends for us.

Small Groups provide 3 things:

1. A place to **connect** with others.

We were not made to do life alone. God created us for community, and groups provide a place for you to connect with others, share life, and grow in faith together.

" yes whatever a person is like, I try to find common ground with him so he will let me tell him about Christ and let Christ save him" 1 Corinthians 9:22

2. A place to **protect** each other.

When we do life together, our problems become smaller as God uses others to bring support and encouragement to our lives. Groups become a place where others don't just know your name but care about what is happening in your life and want to support you in your spiritual journey.

"We know what real love is because Jesus gave up His life for us. So we also ought to give up our lives for our brothers and sisters." 1 John 3:16

3. A place to **grow** together.

"As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another." Proverbs 27:17 We believe every person is created with God-given potential to make a difference in the world. Groups are a place that you can grow with others to become more like Jesus and reach the potential God has put inside you.

Living Waters Small Group Model

We base our Small Groups Model on the early church as described in the Bible in the book of Acts. In Acts, you can read about how small group meetings in homes helped lay the foundation for tremendous growth in the first church in Jerusalem.

"Day after day, in the temple courts and from house to house, they never stopped teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Messiah." Acts 5:42

"You know that I have not hesitated to preach anything that would be helpful to you but have taught you publicly and from house to house." Acts 20:20

4 Things to know about small groups:

1. Our groups are "free market".

We want people to gather together based on things they enjoy and are important to them. Essentially, the things you are already doing in your life are the things that can make up your Small Group! From sports groups to lunch groups, marriage groups to Bible study groups, our groups are as varied as we are.

2. There are "semesters" every year.

Life flows in seasons, and we want to make it easy for you to be in the right Small Group for you in each season. This is why we have new groups that start and stop a few times throughout the year. We have a winter/spring semester and a fall semester. Some groups follow these semesters and others choose to continue throughout the year. 3. Everyone can join a group.

Our hope is for every person at Living Water to be connected in meaningful community through a Small Group. 4. Anyone can host a group.

We believe hosting a group is simple because we all have something to offer others. Whether it's something you are passionate about, an experience you've had that can help others, or an area in which you are looking to grow, hosting a group is a great way to bring people together in meaningful community. Dream Team

All of us were created by God to make a difference in the world around us. God has a place for you where your unique abilities and passions can impact the lives of others. We believe your life will never make sense until you find, develop, and fulfill your purpose. Everyone has something they can do to impact the lives of others. Discover what you do well, and take steps to make a difference.

These are teams that contribute towards making the weekend worship experience happen. There are many different elementsfrom the lights you see on stage, the greeters who meet you at the door, to those who serve in kids church, and others that you never even see. All of these teams and many more are made up of people just like you who have a passion to serve other people and lead people in a growing relationship with Jesus.

We believe there is no great divide between the "ministers" and the "congregation". Everyone has something they can do to impact the lives of others in the Kingdom of God. From our perspective, every member of Living Water is gifted in some area, and every task is important. Discover what you do well and take steps to use your gifts to make a difference. You can start by joining the Dream Team at Step 3 of the Growth Track.

Living Waters' Governance

As you consider investing your heart, time, family, and finances into the life of a church, it is important for you to feel confident in church leadership. Our goal in sharing the details of Living Water's government is that you will understand that our church is structured to support the value's of integrity, accountability, and spiritual authority.

Our church government is made up of three groups:

1. Guided by pastors.

The Pastoral Staff Team is led by the Lead Pastor. This team oversees the day-to-day ministry and operations of the church. These staff pastors serve the congregation and are responsible for the development of the spiritual life of the church.

2. Protected by elders.

The elders are members of the congregation that oversee the finances and direct the provision of the facilities needed by the church. They are appointed by the Senior Pastor and approved by the members. They provide counsel to the Senior Pastor regarding the major financial commitments of the church.

3. Affiliated with the Assemblies of God

The Assemblies of God is a supportive organization that strengthens like minded churches and are willing to provide spiritual protection to the church. They may be called upon to help in accountability matters relating to the Senior Pastor if requested.

Church Finances

At Living Water, we practice tithing for the support of Christ's body, the church, as God commands. We recognize that giving 10% of our income is the Biblical standard for giving.

"be sure to set aside a tenth of all that your fields produce each year" Deuteronomy 14:22-26

"Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the Lord Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it." Malachi 3:10

Many people love to give to God and as they do, they want to feel confident in the church through which they give. At Living Water, we want people to understand they are giving to God through the church, not to the church. We work very hard to make sure that every gift is making a difference in peoples lives. As we openly share the honesty, integrity, and spiritual values that guide the financial practices at Living Water, we believe people can focus on what God is calling them to give and trust that He is leading our church to steward it well.

The giving of your tithes and offerings is worship to Jesus and an expression of the relationship between you and the Lord. The tithes and offerings you give are not considered business transactions, but are considered worship - an expression of gratitude toward God.

Here are 2 ways you can participate in giving

1. Tithe

The tithe, or first-fruits of our labor and income belong to God. We find this principle all through God's Word. Tithing, giving God the first 10% of our income to the local church, is the primary, practical way we acknowledge that God is first (Proverbs 3:9-10).

2. Offerings

An offering is giving over and above the tithe. There is always a lot of vision to give from this house. We want to help missionaries and missions organizations reach more people for Jesus. We want to raise up next generation leaders, we want to be able to improve our campus so that we can always be in a position to reach more people for Christ. So when you give an offering to Kingdom Builders, you are actually helping accelerate the vision of our Church. It's up to the church as a whole to determine the pace, or how quickly vision becomes reality. Be praying and ask God what you should give.
